I hand-pick every single item on this list, often right down to individual feathers. No fly shop scrutinizes its materials more closely than I. My philosophy is simple: If I wouldn't tie with it, I won't sell it. Period.

### **Extra-Select Waterfowl Plumage**

I am proud to offer the finest waterfowl plumage on the market. My experience as a duck hunter and fly tyer allows me to sort and grade waterfowl feathers better than anybody else in the industry. My precise grading means you get no mixed bags as is usually the case. Typically in the tying trade, for example, bags of so-called teal flank will actually contain a mix of several different kinds of duck feathers. All my feathers are hand-picked so you get no waste and all are washed before packaging.
